The Restoration Of Those Things Stolen!

Already Lois and I are experiencing supernatural occurrences that are leaving us both amazed. I want you to be ready for the mega blessing that is being released to those who have fought through and never gave up. There are so many blessings that we are presently living in right now that it would take me three letters to tell you of all the things that have transpired in the last six months.

Let me remind you of a story Lois first wrote about in the January 2003 edition of this newsletter. (You can still read it by going on-line to our website.)

The Wood-Cook Stove (January 2003)

Lois lay upon her bed tossing and turning in her sleep. She was back in Montana at the home we had built and had sold to move to St. Louis and work for Randy Clark. But this wasn't the house she had left. Instead of the clean floors and walls the place was dirty and deserted. Looking around she noticed that even the fine lace curtains she had left for the new owners were gone. Then almost without thinking she knew it was missing. Lois raced around the corner to the kitchen and it was gone. The place where it sat was bare but the emptiness in her spirit was too much for her to take.

The wood-cook stove that we had purchased in Eureka 20 years previously was gone. The one thing that was the hardest to leave had been taken in the middle of the night. Pictures of our girls as they grew up tasting the food Lois had cooked on the stove came to mind. The thoughts of how our old Beagle dog would sleep by the warm stove came to her as well.

Getting up Lois went down stairs and prayed. While in prayer the Lord gave her Philippians 3:7-14 to read but verse 13 stood out the most to her. *"But one thing I do, forgetting those things, which are behind, and reaching forward to those things, which are ahead I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus."*

Her body shaking and tired Lois gave everything to the Lord and went back to sleep. In the morning she called our old realtor friend that had sold the house for us and asked him if he would go out to the place and check up on it for us. Within a few hours he called and confirmed to us that the dream Lois had was true. The people had left, defaulted on their loan, turned the power off in the middle of winter and had stripped the house of the cook stove.

The shock of it all was enormous to us. We had built that home ourselves, raised our daughters there and now we were faced with a Bank that didn't care if the heat was turned on and the pipes would freeze and break nor were they concerned if we would get our money out of the second mortgage we gave the couple so the house could be sold. Lois struggled over the loss of the stove while making sure we could recover some of the

\$50,000 we were losing from them defaulting on the loan. It was not a good time for us. We felt violated and even though we had prophetic words spoken over us of things restored it didn't make the feelings we had any better.

The Wood-Cook Stove (September 2006)

We were back in Kalispell, Montana visiting our good friends when Curtis handed me the phone and said, "Call the antique shop and see if they have any stoves! Here's the number." As I did so I was told that they had 3-4 antique wood cook stoves just in and yes one was a Monarch!

Within a few minutes we were down at the antique store and discovered that they had a monarch stove like my old one but not quite as nice. Then we looked around and saw a 1909 majestic wood cook stove in excellent condition that had just come right out of an old farm house in eastern Montana. You see a Majestic and a Monarch are very similar of the era, much like a Chevy and a Ford would be. But this Majestic was the Cadillac for fancy nickel plating and in twice as good a condition as our old stove had been.



So the Friday of the Global Awakening conference in early November our new wood cook stove was shipped to us. What was even more amazing was the tracking number. It was 333-330 and those of you who know about the Jeremiah 3:33 history that Rex and I have will understand the significance of what that means to us. But it was yet another confirmation to us that our Lord was playing a major part in everything that happened.

As we were telling the developer of the land we had miraculously purchased six months ago about the stove, without his knowing it he began to prophecy to us. When we mentioned that the stove was built in 1909 he stopped us and said, "The year 1909 is very significant to Pennsylvania history and to this area in particular. In that year the Hershey school was opened for the orphans at Hershey and the Christian, Messiah College was founded. That is a very significant year!"

So you would ask, "what does all of this mean? Interesting enough the emblem on the front door of the stove is of a ship, 'called the Majestic' in full sail, sailing on the open sea. Have you been waiting for your ship to come in? Then cast your eyes upon the horizon for they are within site. For some of you it is not one ship but many ships that are coming. Let your spirit rise up within you.

We believe and want to proclaim to you that 2007 is a year of New Beginnings, New Seasons, New Horizons, Fresh Hope, and Expanded Vision, and that 2007 will bring much restoration to that which has been lost not only for us as we have been seeing already but to many of you also.

May you live in His perfect peace as those who keep their minds on Him and meditate on His faithfulness and His mercies new every morning, and may you see His miraculous hand in bringing a new season, restoration and hope to that which has been lost.
